11 November

Purpose

Panel Members

Trigger Action Plans

The Panel considered nine new Trigger Action Plans and re-considered two Trigger Action Plans that had come before the Panel on 14 October 2015.

Decisions of the Panel

All of the Trigger Action Plans were <u>approved</u>.

Additional Matter

The Panel discussed an email from the Project dated 2 November 2015 in response to concerns raised by the Panel concerning particular references to BS8223 and the Noise Insulation Regulations in the Trigger Action Plans.

Decisions of the Panel

- 1. The Panel felt that a simple rewording of the paragraphs containing reference to the acoustic performance of the Noise Insulation Regulations package could have avoided misinterpretation.
- 2. The comments made at previous meetings of the Panel concerning the technical robustness of the acoustical terminology were not addressed in the email and remain a concern.

The Panel made a number of general comments regarding:

- properties constructed prior to 1989 needing to have an asbestos refurbishment and demolition survey.
- all mechanical ventilation units need to have a British Board of Agrément certificate.
