	CHAWF - tunnelling continuing, roughly halfway. Muckaway 315 barge loads = 350,000T; ring 1700 out of 3040 in total Segments delivered by river – 82 barge loads - 1750 rings = 12250 segments. Stopping TBM for Christmas 20/12/21. KEMPF – no marine movements. GREPS – planned stoppage November - cutter head intervention. Stopping TBM for Christmas 16/12/21. River muckaway – 200 barge loads = 80,000T; Road muckaway – 5,800 lorry loads = 95,000T. Production high, quality of material good – very dry which helps with transport. Road/river ratio 55%/45%. Exceeding commitment of 24% by river. 2 barges/24 hours. Segments manufactured in Peterborough, delivered by train to Thamesport, on by river to CHAWF and road to GREPS.	
	TBM Expected at CHAWF April/May 2022. Sites resuming 4/1/22. Presentation for Rainham Marshes SSSI habitat restoration scheme. 7M tonnes of varying waste types (170504 and 190203) are being used to develop the scheme. Key stakeholders are PLA, The Royal Society for the Protection of Birds (RSPB) and Natural England (NE).
