	organisations and public – benefits of river use. Contractor suggested increased flexibility in derogation process. Rigidity		
	meant RTS was applied more carefully and to the level it has. Promoting use of the river when dealing with Planning		
	matters by the Boroughs – needs to be an easier option. RTS has delivered for PUTEF with Additional materials by river.
