EARL PUMPING STATION

The team at the Earl Pumping Station site is permanently covering the shaft that leads down to the Thames Tideway Tunnel. The shaft is shown below, after large primary beams were installed.

From mid-March, site hours will extend until 10pm in the evening on weekdays. This will continue until around the end of May. Most work will be taking place within the shaft, as we will be concreting and finishing all the internal works.

Once the Tideway shaft, tunnelling and underground works at the Earl Pumping Station site are complete, a permanent electrical and control kiosk structure will be built above the ground, to house the equipment needed to operate the sewer.

Finally, we will complete landscaping the site, before demobilising, which is currently planned for February 2025.
