

BLACKFRIARS BRIDGE FORESHORE PILE REMOVAL – 2024

Work on the new super sewer at Tideway's Blackfriars Bridge Foreshore site has progressed well this year and we are now in a position to start removing the piles from the western cofferdam. This is the temporary area of land that was built into the river that has allowed construction to take place. The area of piles we need to remove is shown in the aerial photograph - the L-shaped section below, between the two white cranes.



We aim to start pulling piles in the western cofferdam in the week commencing Monday, 29 April.

Works will take place during core hours – Monday to Friday (08:00-18:00) and Saturday (08:00-13:00). There will be no Sunday working.

While these works are tidal, we will make every effort to use City Hours. Whenever possible, noisy working hours will be restricted to: 08:00 to 10:00; Midday to 14:00 and 16:00 to 18:00

We will not be working on the two bank holidays in May (Mondays, 6th & 27th)

We will be using the vibratory-hammer method to extract the piles. Noise and vibration levels will be monitored throughout the works. All extracted materials will be removed by barge.

We aim to complete the extraction works by the end of July 2024. We will keep you updated as we progress and of any issues which may prolong the extraction works. We will also issue a weekly update to keep you notified about the predicted noisy times the following week.
