

WORKS UPDATE: PILING AND CABIN REMOVAL

Since our last update, we have seen good progress at our Putney Embankment Foreshore site with the completion of our temporary sheet piling, west of Putney Bridge. A total of 458 piles, in addition to 16,000 tonnes of aggregate, were delivered by barge - keeping over 800 lorries off the local road network.

We have recently received delivery of a large piling rig on site that will be used for the pre-auguring piling works that will start from mid-October and continue until the end of the month. Following these works we will commence the installation of the permanent piles. This uses a method of piling which is less disruptive than our previous sheet piling, but we will continue to monitor noise and vibration levels throughout these works. To facilitate the moving of materials on site we will have a large crane arriving onto site week commencing Monday 22 October.

You may also have recently noticed the arrival of our new office accommodation. These units have been placed adjacent to Waterman's Green and will be three storeys in height. We will be fitting these out over the next few weeks prior to occupying them in early November.

Once the new office accommodation fit-out is completed, we will need to remove the Embankment cabins that have been used as office space over the past year. To do so, we will need to close a small section of Putney Embankment, between Lower Richmond Road and the alleyway opposite Putney Pier. Some parking bays will also be suspended along the north side of Putney Embankment during this time. The road closure and bay suspensions are due to start on **Monday 5 November** and will last for two weeks.

All works on site will take place from Monday – Friday, 08:00 – 18:00, but we may also need to utilise our Saturday shift from 08:00 – 13:00.
