NIGHT WORK TO INSTALL THE ACOUSTIC ENCLOSURE

We will be installing an acoustic enclosure above the shaft at Greenwich Pumping Station. The acoustic enclosure will contain construction activities within and around the shaft, reducing noise as a result. Excavation of the shaft will then take place within the acoustic enclosure, followed by tunnelling, which is currently planned to start mid-2019.

Due to the proximity of the acoustic enclosure to the DLR viaduct, some construction activities will need to take place at night when the DLR is not operational.

The majority of work will take place during day time working hours, with limited essential night works permitted between the hours of 22:00 and 07:00, Monday to Sunday. This is for preparatory works, such as moving cranes, with critical activities only allowed between approximately 00:30 / 01:30 to 05:00 (hours the DLR is not operating). Where possible, night works will be set up during the day to reduce the amount of plant movement at night.

We will erect the enclosure's steel structure followed by the acoustic cladding and the roof. These works require mechanical tools, cranes and mobile elevating working platforms.

These night works are planned to start from Monday 19 November, with the steel structure and gantry crane erection planned for the first 4 weeks, followed by the cladding and roof through December and January 2019.

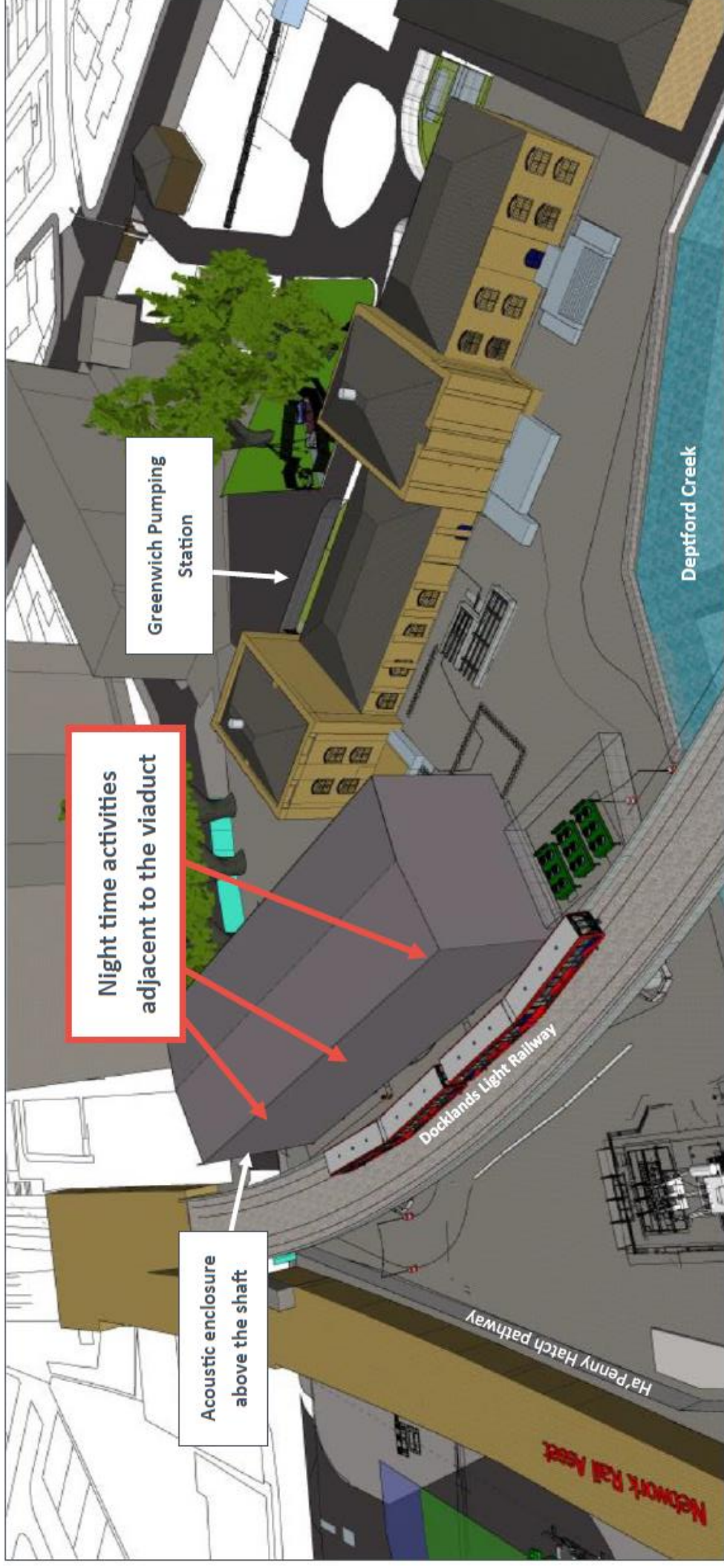
We plan to complete the enclosure in February 2019.

Some of this work may be noisy. We apologise for any disturbance and will do our best to minimise disruption. If you feel you may be affected by this work, we may be able to help you. This is particularly relevant to anyone who has a medical condition which may be exacerbated by these works, or to shift workers.

Acoustic enclosure



A shaft is an underground vertical access to facilitate tunnelling of the Thames Tideway Tunnel from Greenwich Tunnel from Greenwich Pumping Station. It will be up to 60 metres deep.

We will be installing an acoustic enclosure above the shaft. This will contain construction activities within and around the shaft, including tunnelling, and reduce noise as a result.
