### CHANGES TO NINE ELMS LANE

Starting on 21 January 2019 the layout of a section of Nine Elms Lane, outside of the Heathwall Pumping Station worksite, will be changing. These changes are to facilitate the Tideway works whilst ensuring minimal impact to the local community and road users. The works will include:

- A new pedestrian crossing. This is being installed to replace the existing temporary pedestrian crossing and which will improve road safety for pedestrians;
- A new cycle lane, in both directions;
- Removal of the existing traffic island at the Ponton Road junction;
- Removal of the bus lanes for this section of the road. The eastbound bus lane will become part of the Tideway worksite;
- The eastbound footpath which will remain open but will be shut down intermittently during off-peak hours to allow for deliveries to the worksite.

These works will take approximately eight weeks to complete. The road will remain open during the works, with traffic management and diversions providing the necessary safe working areas to complete the works in stages. We will provide progress and updates as necessary during the works.

These changes will improve road safety and ensure smooth traffic flow in the area.
