Decision:	<p>The proposed unit would not have the same inherent sound reduction properties as the Titan Sonair and can be quite noisy.</p> <p>The Panel wishes to leave the practical solution of providing suitable and sufficient mechanical ventilation for the contractor to agree with the claimant.</p>

9	The Panel met with the ICC and Tim Prager, Chair of the Carnwath Road Riverside Community Liaison Working Group (CLWG) at their request.

General matter:	<p>The Panel has had cause to request air quality and noise monitoring data for the Chambers Wharf area on an ad hoc basis. We would find it helpful to have the following information on an on-going basis in order to help us determine claims that come up for review:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Copies of Noise Monitoring Reports and Air Quality Monitoring Reports for the Chambers Wharf area. The ICP have already received reports for Air Quality Monitoring through to September 2018 and therefore for the Air Quality Reports it will only be necessary to provide those reports from October 2018 onwards on a monthly basis. • In respect of the Noise Monitoring Reports the ICP require both the original baseline report (which we assume was compiled by AECOM) and all Noise Monitoring Reports from the commencement of Tideway works on the site to the present date. As with the Air Quality Reports we will also require that these are provided on a monthly basis going forwards.
