

# Monthly Report of the Independent Compensation Panel Chair

## September 2015

The Independent Compensation Panel (ICP) did not meet in September 2015. However, ICP members have been selected for three meetings in October to consider Trigger Action Plans (TAPs), commencing with the most urgent 'pre-triggered' buildings on 2 October.

### Other Work

#### *Consultation on Proposed Changes to the Offsite Mitigation and Compensation Policies*

I received no comments from local authorities on the proposed changes to the *Exceptional Hardship Procedure* and *Non-statutory Off-site Mitigation and Compensation Policy*. The new documents have now come into effect and will be published on The Project's website in October, incorporating the new branding.

#### *Site Tour*

I undertook a tour of the main areas around the construction sites on 22 September in order to gain an appreciation of the juxtaposition of the sites and sensitive receptors. The tour was organised by staff from Property & Facilities, six of whom accompanied the Independent Complaints Commissioner (ICC), the Exceptional Hardship Specialists and myself. It was a most valuable day and I am appreciative of the staff for making this opportunity possible.
