

Monthly Report of the Independent Compensation Panel Chair

October 2016

The Independent Compensation Panel (the 'Panel') met on two occasions in October 2016.

11 October (ICP38)

Purpose

To determine compensation claims for four medical special cases.

Panel Members

I was joined by a Medical Specialist and a Noise & Vibration Specialist.

Decisions of the Panel

Medical special case 1

The Panel re-considered medical case 2350-TDWAY-TTTUN-990-ZZ-OL-100003 and approved the installation of the sound insulation mitigation package in the additional bedrooms requested by the Claimant.

Medical special case 2

The Panel re-considered medical case 2350-TDWAY-TTTUN-990-ZZ-OL-100007 following the receipt of additional information and approved the claim for respite.

Medical special case 3

The Panel considered medical case 2350-TDWAY-TTTUN-990-ZZ-OL-100010 in relation to dust. The Panel could not determine the claim and requested dust monitoring data from the Project.

Medical special case 4

The Panel considered medical case 2350-TDWAY-TTTUN-990-ZZ-OL-100009 for the installation of the sound insulation mitigation package. The claim for the installation of the sound insulation mitigation package in all habitable rooms was Approved. Further, it was recommended that the front door furniture be overhauled to prevent the door vibrating.

11 October (ICP39)

Purpose

To consider an Addendum to the Pier Head School Trigger Action Plan.

Panel Members

I was joined by a Noise & Vibration Specialist and a Building Surveyor.

Decisions of the Panel
