

Monthly Report of the Independent Compensation Panel Chair

September 2018

The Independent Compensation Panel (the 'Panel') met on three occasions in September 2018.

3 September (ICP97)

Purpose

To determine special medical case claims.

Panel Members

I was joined by a Medical Specialist and a Noise & Vibration Specialist.

The Panel:

- Considered 4 special medical case claims, including one relating to the base plug pour at the Carnwath Road worksite.

I issued the Minutes at the end of the meeting.

11 September (ICP98)

Purpose

To determine special medical case and compensation claims.

Panel Members

I was joined by a Medical Specialist, a Noise & Vibration Specialist and Compensation Specialists, as appropriate.

The Panel:

- Considered 19 matters in total, comprising:
 - 9 involving a compensation claim element, including one relating to loss of earnings due to the base plug pour at the Carnwath Road worksite
 - 13 involving a special medical case claim element, including one relating to the base plug pour at the Carnwath Road worksite, which we dealt with by teleconference on 6 September 2018 as a matter of urgency.
- We finalised our comments on Tideway's draft list of supporting documents for loss of rent compensation claims.
- The Panel considered options put forward by Tideway for the on-going consideration of claims from a business affected by Tideway's construction activities.
- We discussed some business matters, including the *Non-statutory off-site mitigation and compensation policy*, the *DCO* and financial loss and environmental impact frameworks and ICP processes. I was also joined by the ICP's Building Surveyor and ICP's Administrator for this discussion. All were asked to submit to me 3 things that the ICP does well and 3 things that require improvement.

I issued the Minutes within 48 hours of the end of the meeting.

25 September (ICP99)

Purpose

To determine special medical case claims.

Panel Members

I was joined by a Medical Specialist and a Noise & Vibration Specialist.

The Panel:

- Considered 12 matters in total, comprising:
 - 10 special medical case claims, including a visit to a Claimant's property to assess her claim
 - 2 outstanding noise mitigation matters (Leeward Court TAP and Jacobs House mechanical ventilation)
 - reported on the ICP's visit during the Carnwath Road base plug pour

I issued the Minutes a little over 48 hours after the end of the meeting.

Other Activities

The Noise & Vibration Specialist and myself visited the area around the Carnwath Road worksite on the evening of 7 September to assess the impacts of the base plug pour.
