

ALBERT EMBANKMENT PILE BREAKDOWN

Our works at our Albert Embankment site are progressing well. We are coming to the end of the marine works for Cofferdam 2 which we aim to complete by the end of March.

In mid-March, as part of our landside works in Cofferdam 1, we will begin to reduce the size of the bored piles around the perimeter of our shaft by 1 metre, allowing us to tie them together using a steal and concrete capping beam. In order to reduce the piles, we will be using an excavator with a hydraulic breaker attachment. We will be employing an innovative technique of pre-splitting the piles to reduce the noise from the break out as much as possible. This work is essential before we can begin excavation.

Below is a plan showing the location of the piles to be reduced. This will take approximately three weeks to complete and take place during our normal working hours Monday to Friday **08:00** to **18:00** and Saturday **08:00** to **13:00**. During the activity we will continue to monitor noise and vibrations.
