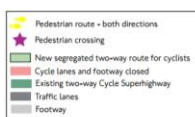
WORKS UPDATE

CYCLE SUPERHIGHWAY AND FOOTPATH CHANGES AT VICTORIA EMBANKMENT

We recently contacted you about the construction work we are doing at Victoria Embankment Foreshore for the Thames Tideway Tunnel and some changes we will be making to the road layout.

These changes will come into effect on Monday 19th June and will mean diverting the existing East-West Cycle Superhighway (CS3) past the worksite, between Northumberland Avenue and Horse Guards Avenue. The cycle superhighway will remain open and Cyclists will have segregated, two-way cycle lanes throughout the works. There will be some minor changes to the layout of CS3 in this area, however this will not have an impact on your cycle journey time.

The Thames path along Victoria Embankment from Northumberland Avenue to Horse Guards Avenue will also be closed from this date. There will be clear signage to direct pedestrians to the other side of the road, alongside Whitehall Gardens.



WORKING HOURS

- Standard working hours are 08:00-18:00 weekdays and 08:00-13:00 Saturdays. Some of these works will take place at night to limit disruption

WHAT TO EXPECT

- During the works, roads in the surrounding area may be busier than usual. Please plan ahead and allow extra time for your journey
- There will be diversion signs for pedestrians and cyclists

WHAT WE WILL DO

- Keep you informed of any relevant changes
- Monitor air quality and noise levels on site
