HAMMERSMITH PUMPING STATION UPDATE

Work at our Hammersmith Pumping Station site are progressing well as we continue work on the Connection Tunnel, Inlet Channel and the Interception Chamber.

As part of our works, this month we will be extending our site into the Thames Water pumping station compound in order for us to undertake a new external services installation.

When we obtain this section of the site from Thames Water, we will begin with the installation of new hoarding within the existing boundary wall neighbouring Chancellors Road.

Once the hoardings are installed, we will begin with the breaking out of the concrete/tarmac surface area before undertaking a series of excavations. Works will also include installing a cofferdam that requires the installation of sheet and concrete piles. We will update you prior to these works taking place.

All works to this section of the site will take place during our normal standard working hours: Monday – Friday, 8am – 6pm. Saturday's working hours are between 8am and 1pm.

We will continue to monitor noise and dust levels and use best practice to minimise any disruption.
