Site visit: Philpot Square, Carnwath Road at 9am. The noise expert visited the building and obtained access to the first and second floor stairwell and to external areas adjacent the rubbish chute. The gantry crane was in operation on the site. It was noted that the conveyor system and muck bin area is not in direct line of sight from those areas accessed by the noise expert. It was noted that a number of windows facing onto Carnwath Road were open on the building. The chair and another panel member will undertake a night-time site visit later this month.

The Panel does not believe that the occupiers of the property will be significantly adversely affected by noise from the on-going slurry treatment works construction and the information provided does not suggest that there will be a significant adverse impact of noise on the applicant.
