










Putney Embankment Foreshore - Timeline



Putney Embankment Foreshore More by river

- Change to overall works method, using larger barges, has resulted in fewer barge movements on the river
- Each barge movement equates to approximately 50 HGV's removed from the local road network
- Since October we have had 19 barges arrive at Putney Embankment Foreshore, keeping approximately 950 lorries off the road



Road traffic



- 4.2m tonnes of material moved by river
- Removing 262,000 lorries from London's roads

Boat Races









Main Worksite Overview – Design, Planning & Construction









Pipe-Jacking set-up






Upcoming Works

- Commence construction of hydraulic structures




