Decision	Requested mitigation is NOT AWARDED
Details of the award	The claimants have appealed the previous decision of the ICP. The claimants had previously identified that, because of noise from the site and the present requirement to work from home, they are having to keep windows closed which leads to an unacceptable level of solar gain. They have requested that they should be allocated funds to assist with this issue and have requested an allowance for mobile air conditioning units.
	The Panel reviewed information from the site with respect to predicted noise levels from culvert excavation and breaking out works and noted that the noisier activities will be confined to two periods of the day, 1000 hrs to 1200 hrs and 1400 hrs to1600 hrs for a period of three weeks commencing 3 rd June 2020. The specific activities are anticipated to occur during a period of time when daily temperatures are forecast to be rather lower than have been experienced over the preceding two months. Additionally, there will be works on the site on the 6 th and 7 th June 2020 with respect to the removal of a staircase from the shaft which will occur between 0800



	hrs to 1600 hrs. It is not anticipated that the staircase removal will be particularly disturbing.
	The Panel has further considered this request for air conditioning units; however, it has determined that, in this instance, an award is <u>not</u> made as the Panel does not anticipate that exposure to the higher levels of noise will continue for a prolonged period of time when overheating within the property might otherwise occur with windows closed.
	The Panel will further review this and other similar cases when the new s61 for ongoing works becomes available.
	All awards are subject to Tideway's Guidelines for Implementation of ICP decisions.
