

Monthly Report of the Independent Compensation Panel Chair

June 2020

The Independent Compensation Panel (the 'Panel') met on three occasions in June 2020.

1. 2 June 2020 (ICP Meeting #153)

Purpose

To determine one special case claim.

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Medical Specialist
- Noise & Vibration Specialist

The Panel:

- Met by video conference to consider one claim on an urgent basis associated with Tideway works at Hammersmith.

Minutes were issued within 5 working days of the end of the meeting.

2. 9 June 2020 (ICP Meeting #154)

Purpose

To determine medical and special case claims and other matters.

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Medical Specialist
- Noise & Vibration Specialist

The Panel:

- Met by video conference to consider nine claims, two for medical and seven special case claims.
- These matters were associated with Tideway works at:
 - Kirtling Street;
 - Hammersmith Pumping Station; and
 - Carnwath Road.

Minutes were issued within 6 working days of the end of the meeting.

3. 23 June 2020 (ICP Meeting #154)

Purpose

To determine compensation, medical & special case claims and other matters.

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Medical Specialist
- Noise & Vibration Specialist
- Compensation Specialists

The Panel:

- Met by video conference to consider sixteen claims including one for compensation, one for medical and fourteen special case claims.
- These matters were associated with Tideway works at:

 - Cremorne Wharf;
 - Putney Embankment Foreshore;
 - Chambers Wharf;
 - Hammersmith Pumping Station; and
 - Carnwath Road.
