

Monthly Report of the Independent Compensation Panel Chair

September 2020

The Independent Compensation Panel (the 'Panel') met on two occasions in September 2020.

1. 8 September 2020 (ICP Meeting #160)

Purpose

To determine compensation, special cases and other matters.

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Medical Specialist
- Noise & Vibration Specialist
- Compensation Specialists

The Panel:

- Met by video conference to consider five compensation cases, two medical cases and two special case claims.
- These matters were associated with Tideway works at:
 - Kirtling Street and Heathwall;
 - Chambers Wharf;
 - King Edward Memorial Park Foreshore; and
 - Falconbrook.

Minutes were issued within 6 working days of the end of the meeting.

2. 22 September 2020 (ICP Meeting #161)

Purpose

To determine compensation, medical & special case claims and other matters.

- Compensation specialists

The Panel:

- Met by video conference to consider three compensation claims, one medical claim, three

special case claims and one claim which had been referred back to the Panel by the ICC for further review.

 - Albert Embankment;
 - Chambers Wharf;
 - Earl Pumping Station;
 - Nine Elms Pier; and
 - Cremorne Wharf.

Minutes were issued within 9 working days of the end of the meeting.
