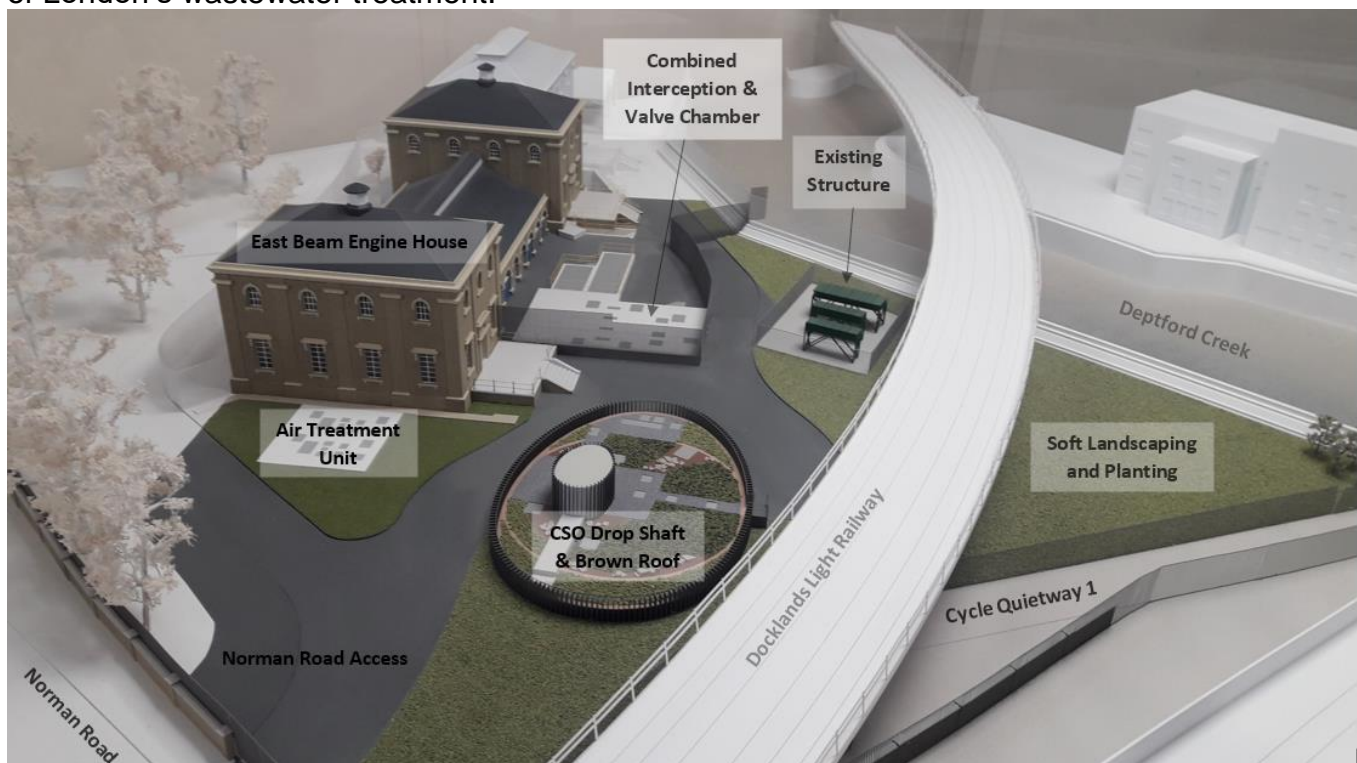
GREENWICH PUMPING STATION

Tideway has made a draft application to the Royal Borough of Greenwich for the detailed design of the permanent above ground works.

Once the Tideway shaft, tunnelling and sub-surface works at the Greenwich Pumping Station site are completed, a number of permanent above ground structures will be constructed.

The structures and works subject to this application include the Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) drop shaft enclosure and ventilation house, CSO interception chamber, an air treatment unit, surface water drainage and interpretative artwork. The application also includes associated hard and soft landscaping.

These works will result in improved aesthetic, amenity and enhanced local biodiversity. The works are also intended to complement the listed building and structures on site and highlight the evolution of London's wastewater treatment.

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The Thames Tideway Tunnel project is authorised under Thames Water Utilities Limited Development Consent Order 2014 (as amended), granted by the Secretaries of State in September 2014. This approved the principle of the development, including the necessity and location of the permanent above ground works and their maximum height.

This means that the scope of what the Royal Borough of Greenwich can approve and the comments that they can consider, is limited to the size, height, visual appearance, and materiality of the proposed structures and works because the application only relates to the above ground materials, finishes and soft & hard landscaping.

Under the Development Consent Order, Tideway is required to provide this draft submission to Royal Borough of Greenwich for comment before submitting the final application for the above ground permanent works. The final application is expected to be submitted later this year or in early 2022.

The draft submission is to ultimately discharge requirements set out in Schedule 3 of the Development Consent Order:

- GREPS2 - Detailed design approval for permanent above-ground structures
- GREPS6 - Landscaping works
- GREPS11 - Specification of accesses (operational)
- GREPS12 - Surface Water Drainage
- PW11 - Interpretation strategy

The draft application has now been submitted and the Royal Borough of Greenwich has commenced the consultation on the draft proposals, whereby the closing date is listed on their website.
