Details of the award	The Panel reviewed the information pack provided. The Panel considered the claim for loss of rental income and recognises that, by accepting the reduced rent, the applicant had mitigated his losses. Adopting a similar approach to that adopted in previous claims, the Panel considered that the reduced rental, being a significant further reduction from the previously achieved rent reflecting Tideway works, reflected the exceptional circumstances at the time of the letting and anticipates an improvement at

The Panel accepts the recommendation of the forensic accountants and awards the amount claimed for the period July to December (inclusive) 2021. The Panel notes that a full review will be undertaken of the approach to the assessment of compensation for the whole of the period of Tideway works when the next claim is received, in order to be satisfied that the payments made reflect the actual losses to the claimant caused by Tideway works.
	The Panel also intends to undertake a site inspection shortly to consider the nature and extent of ongoing Tideway works and their impact on the Thai Square premises.
