Details of the award	<p>This claimant is known to the Panel and the ICP previously made a home visit to the claimant's property.</p> <p>The Panel note that there will be on-going demolition works associated with the muck bin area; however, the Panel has not seen a s61 for those specific activities and is therefore unaware of the level of noise which may be experienced at the claimant's home. Until such time as information in respect of noise levels, frequency of occurrence etc. become available to the Panel, this claim is deferred.</p> <p>The Panel requires full details of the method of demolition which will be utilised, any proposed noise mitigation and a programme for the demolition works from the contractors.</p> <p><u>All awards are subject to Tideway's Guidelines for Implementation of ICP decisions.</u></p> <p><u>https://www.tideway.london/media/4138/guidelines-for-implementation-of-icp-decisions_feb-2020.pdf</u></p>

Details of the award	<p>In November 2020, the ICP made an award of two fans and the electricity costs for one year. The claimant is struggling to pay for the continued running of these fans.</p> <p>The Panel is aware of the claimant's health issues.</p> <p>The Panel notes that the claimant's property is significantly shielded by intervening buildings from the construction site activities.
