Decision	NO AWARD REQUIRED
	The claimants experience noise from the site and vehicles in Norman Road. The Panel have viewed two videos that clearly demonstrate that activities during the daytime, outside of the claimant's property, are noisy. The claimant has requested a number of management measures that should be implemented by the contractor, which include:
Details of the award	 Stop generator or compressor after 6PM or 8PM. Do not work or make noise after 6PM. Cover generator with more acoustic blankets to reduce noise. Stop parking vehicles in front of Bellville House. Reduce the time to drive "cleaning vehicle" to wash street. Do not allow worker operator machine (e.g. cutting machine) outside of shaft. Reduce the noise when workers speak in front of gate.



	The Panel note that no specific claim has been made for the Panel to determine. The Panel requires that Tideway remind the contractor to implement best practicable means in respect of noise management for the site in order to avoid wherever possible noise nuisance occurring.

Details of the award	The claimant works from home for himself and does not have an office to use. He reports that he has to schedule his calls accordingly and sometimes has to hire a small office for this purpose.
	The Panel is aware of the on-going construction activities at the site although are somewhat surprised that noise would be particularly disturbing at the distance involved.
	The Panel has determined to make an offer of an award of one set of noise reducing headphones to a maximum cost of £100 to assist with communication when working. If the claimant continues to find difficulty in carrying out his work then a claim for access to office accommodation could be considered.

	The Panel has determined to make an award of 2 No. pairs of noise cancelling headphones to a maximum cost of £100 each set.
	Additionally, the claimant is directed towards Tideway's procedure for the award of blackout blinds.
