Site visit to:	
Chambers Wharf site 23 March 2023	Two members of the Panel visited the site and locations in the immediate vicinity of the site and observed some breaking out of concrete and activities associated with the piling works. It was noted that the works were not particularly noisy when observed from within the site offices and were intermittent in nature.

Details of the award	<p>The Panel is aware of the personal circumstances of the claimants and the location of the property relative to the present site activities.</p> <p>The Panel has reviewed a video supplied by the claimants which clearly identifies breaking out works in the vicinity of their property. The Panel note that the video was clearly recorded outside of the property and does not therefore represent the noise levels which would otherwise be experienced internally with windows closed. The breaking out works relate to the re-construction of the Kirtling Street road, which it is understood will be completed by the end of April 2023. The construction works have apparently been programmed to occur intermittently in order to minimise noise disturbance.</p> <p>The Panel has determined to make an award of respite until the end of April 2023.</p>

Details of the award	<p>The Panel is fully aware of the personal circumstances of the claimant and her family. Details of the award	<p>The Panel is aware of the location of the claimant’s property with respect to the Chambers Wharf construction site. The Panel has recently visited the site area and noted that there were activities associated with the breaking out of concrete and piling works. Those works were occurring intermittently at the time of the site visit.</p> <p>The Panel has considered the evidence available to it in respect of existing and future site activities; however, the Panel considers that the provision of a fully fitted air conditioning system at this stage of the project would be a disproportionate level of mitigation.</p> <p>The Panel makes an offer of an award of two portable air conditioning units. Details of the award	<p>The Panel is aware of the location of the claimant's property in relation to the site and has reviewed photographs of light trespass towards the property.</p> <p>Tideway has a separate procedure for dealing with aspects of light trespass and the claimant is referred to that procedure.
