<b>Applicant Reference</b>	The Panel considered the information contained in pack <b>2350-TDWAY-TTTUN-990-ZZ-ZZ-739272</b> as well as various email exchanges between the claimants/ICP Admin and the claimants/Tideway Mitigation.
<b>Relevant Tideway site</b>	Chambers Wharf
<b>Decision</b>	<b>AWARDED</b>
<b>Details of the award</b>	<p>The Chair of the ICP carried out a home visit to the claimant's property on the 15th November 2023. The visit lasted 1.5 hrs in which time the Chair was able to obtain first-hand information from both claimants the requirements of their claims, to be considered alongside information obtained from a previous home visit carried out by the Medical Specialist and the Noise &amp; Vibration Specialist.</p> <p>Prior to accessing the claimant's property, the Chair carried out a walkabout around the general area of the CHAWF site and noted that at that time there was no noticeable noisy activities occurring on the site. The general findings of the home visit are identified separately below for each claimant.</p> <p>Claimant 1: The Panel is aware of the programme of construction works in 2024 and the extent to which it is difficult to identify exactly when particularly noise events will occur.</p>

	<p><b>The Panel has determined that the existing award, which is presently being managed by Tideway Mitigation, should be extended to the end of July 2024.</b></p> <p>The end of July 2024 should get the CHAWF site beyond the significantly noisy works and the Panel would not anticipate any request for an extension of this award after that date.</p> <p><b>Claimant 2: The Panel has determined that the previous award should be amended to provide Claimant 2 with access to the ‘specified office space at the costs identified up to the end of July 2024.</b></p> <p>The end of July 2024 should get the CHAWF site beyond the significantly noisy works and the Panel would not anticipate any request for an extension of this award for SB after that date.</p> <p><b><u>All awards are subject to Tideway’s Guidelines for Implementation of ICP decisions.</u></b></p> <p><b><u><a href="https://www.tideway.london/media/4138/guidelines-for-implementation-of-icp-decisions_feb-2020.pdf">https://www.tideway.london/media/4138/guidelines-for-implementation-of-icp-decisions_feb-2020.pdf</a></u></b></p>
