Details of the award	Four videos have been submitted with the claim which the Panel has reviewed. The videos appear to have been taken from either within the property but with the ventilation door open or from the balcony. The videos sound like concrete breaking but could be other pneumatic devices. The noise, which is at an unknown level, is loud and disturbing; however, the Panel does not know how loud and disturbing this would be internally with the ventilation door shut. The claimant is requesting respite for herself and noise cancelling
	headphones for her son who works from home. The site update of the 22nd of December 2023 was taken into
	consideration and, the Panel notes the information in respect of the acoustic enclosure doors; however, it is our understanding that these are the large doors which face towards the north and therefore noise from these open doors would not impact upon the claimant's property which is to the south of the shed.
	The Panel has considered this claim very carefully in respect of the claimant's health issues and makes an award of respite until the end of June 2024 at the standard rate. The Panel is prepared to review any claims beyond June 2024 when they will have

	further information in respect of site activities and the construction programme.
	The Panel also makes an award of one set of noise cancelling headphones, at a cost of up to £100, for her son in order to facilitate working from home.

Details of the award	There have been multiple previous claims and the claimant's circumstances, previous and on-going health issues are known to the Panel.
	At ICP meeting # 243 on the 14th of November 2023, the claimant and her family were awarded respite until the Xmas break. On the 18th of December 2023, she sent an e-mail to TT requesting clarifications but also requesting that the above award was extended to continue after the Xmas break.
	The site update of the 22nd of December 2023 was taken into consideration.
	The Panel has considered this claim very carefully and has determined to award respite at the standard rate, to each family member until the end of June 2024. The respite days may be aggregated together to allow short breaks to be taken away at the equivalent cost of the daily respite. The Panel considers that the structure of the award adequately provides flexibility as to how the award is utilised.
	The request for cash compensation is not awarded as the Panel only awards financial compensation in respect of business losses e.g. loss of rent etc.
