	The ICP has previously visited the claimant's home. She has made various claims with the last one being considered by the ICP at meeting # 248 on Tuesday 19th of December 2023.
	The claimant is seeking an extension to the award made at that meeting if the works at the site are due to continue beyond the end of February 2024. She has provided one video of vibratory activity, possibly pile removal at Phoenix Wharf
Deteile of the award	Site updates for Phoenix Wharf and Greenwich of the 14th of February 2024 were taken into account.
Details of the award	The works schedule for the acoustic shed removal also indicates night works until the end of February and then day works only until the end of April.
	The works on the Phoenix Wharf site are due to continue until the end of March but daytime only and with no night-time works beyond the end of February associated with the acoustic shed removal.
	The Panel has reviewed all of the available information and has determined to make an award of respite for each family member at the standard rate until the end of March 2024.

	At ICP meeting # 248, an award was made. The claimant has now come back to the ICP requesting that the compensation award due to the noise pollution from the Tideway sites should be extended into March/April if the noise from these sites is to continue.

	The request to extend the existing respite until and including 3 rd March 2024 is awarded.
Details of the award	The Panel is aware that, from a very recent site visit on the 25th of January 2024 and information in respect of the site activities, that work at the site is minimal and hence disturbance may only occur for limited periods of time. Based on the low level of construction activity at the site, a further award is not made.
