GREENWICH PUMPING STATION CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

The team at the Greenwich Pumping Station site is continuing construction works on and around the Thames Water Pumping Station site.

As we approach the end of construction on the project later in 2025, the local Greenwich team is working on site reinstatement and planned architectural and landscaping works.

FOOTWAY AND CYCLEWAY C10

From Monday 9 June the footway and cycleway will be closed for the installation of security features, drop kerbing and the final layer of tarmac.

The closure will be during the day, for around four hours from 10am, over 3 days.

NORMAN ROAD

Work on the Norman Road footpath and carriageway adjacent to the site, as well as on the DLR viaduct, will require some temporary lane closures. We plan to close part of the road from mid-July for around 3 days. Access for pedestrians will be maintained at all times.

EAST BEAM ENGINE HOUSE

The Victorian, grade 2 listed, East Beam Engine House has been renovated with new doors, balustrade and roof tiles.

PHOENIX WHARF

Deptford Creek ecological enhancement works are planned to begin later this year. These will be subject to tidal levels and may sometimes require an early start (4am - 7am) or later finish (6pm-9pm) as a result, but are not expected to be noisy.

In front of the Trinity Laban Dance Centre we will be improving the intertidal terraces on the river walls, to help them fulfil their ecological purpose for invertebrates and plant life.

Gravel will be installed on the riverbed as well, to return it closer to its state before Tideway project tunnelling works.

ARCHITECTURE & LANDSCAPING

Further landscaping works within the site boundary will continue into July.
