Monthly Report of the Independent Compensation Panel Chair

May 2025

The Independent Compensation Panel (the 'Panel') met on two occasions in May 2025.

1. 13 May 2025 (ICP Meeting #281)

Purpose

To determine medical, special, compensation and fast-track claims (if applicable).

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Noise Specialist;
- Medical Specialist; and
- Compensation Specialists.

The Panel:

- The Panel met via video conference to consider four claims:
 - one medical claim;
 - one TAPS claim;
 - one respite claim from a new claimant where it was deemed that the claim fell under the fast-track system; and
 - one claim for loss of rent.
- The medical claimant had already been made an award but felt that (a) was requesting additional respite, and (b) asked questions about how the previous award was determined. The ICP Chair addressed these questions in the minutes.
- These matters were associated with Tideway works at Chambers Wharf.

The minutes were issued within five working days of the meeting.

2. 27 May 2025 (ICP Meeting #282)

Purpose

To determine medical, special, compensation and fast-track claims (if applicable).

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Medical Specialist;
- Noise Specialist; and
- Compensation Specialists.

The Panel:

- Met via video conference to consider three claims:
 - \circ ~ one respite claim for a previous claimant;
 - \circ one claim from a houseboat resident (living close to the Chambers Wharf site); and
 - \circ one claim for loss of rent.

- These matters were associated with Tideway works at:
 - Chambers Wharf; and
 - Earl Pumping Station.
