Monthly Report of the Independent Compensation Panel Chair

June 2025

The Independent Compensation Panel (the 'Panel') met on three occasions in June 2025.

1. 10 June 2025 (ICP Meeting #283)

Purpose

To determine medical, special and fast-track claims (if applicable).

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Noise Specialist; and
- Medical Specialist.

The Panel:

- The Panel met via video conference to consider one medical claim and one claim for respite.
- The medical claim was from an existing claimant who now wished to add her partner to the award as he had moved in to act as her carer.
- The respite claim was for a houseboat tenant making their first claim.
- These matters were associated with Tideway works at Chambers Wharf.

The minutes were issued within four working days of the meeting.

2. Ad hoc meeting 13 June 2025 (ICP Meeting #284)

Purpose

The Panel members were conducting visits to Tideway sites at Carnwath Road, Chambers Wharf and Earl Pumping Station. As the Panel members were available on this date it was decided to have an ad hoc meeting to review a retrospective claim submitted by a medical claimant.

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Medical Specialist; and
- Noise Specialist.

The Panel:

- The claimant was an existing medical claimant who wished to make a claim for a weekend break that had already taken place as it had been timed to avoid a forthcoming surgical procedure.
 - o These matters were associated with Tideway works at Chambers Wharf.

The minutes were issued within two working days of the meeting.

3. 24 June 2025 (ICP Meeting #285)

Purpose

To determine medical and special claims and the possible extension of all fast-track awards previously made to residents close to Tideway's Chambers Wharf site.

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Medical Specialist; and
- Noise Specialist.

The Panel:

- Met via video conference to consider:
 - Previous fast-track awards made to residents living close to Tideway's Chambers Wharf site; and
 - A claim from a previous claimant who was insisting that vibration from the site had damaged his property and refrigerator.
- These matters were associated with Tideway works at:
 - Victoria Embankment Foreshore; and
 - o Chambers Wharf.

The minutes were issued within eight working days of the meeting.
