# **July 2025**

The Independent Compensation Panel (the 'Panel') met on three occasions in July 2025.

#### 8 July 2025 (ICP Meeting #287)

# **Purpose**

To determine medical, special and fast-track claims (if applicable).

#### **Panel Members**

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Noise Specialist; and
- Medical Specialist.

#### The Panel:

- met via video conference to consider:
  - o four claims from houseboat residents (all of whom were new claimants); and
  - o one appeal from a claimant wishing to make an amendment to a prior award.
- These matters were associated with Tideway works at:
  - o Chambers Wharf; and
  - o Earl Pumping Station.
