Monthly Report of the Independent Compensation Panel Chair

October 2025

The Independent Compensation Panel (the 'Panel') met on two occasions in October 2025.

1. 14 October 2025 (ICP Meeting #295)

Purpose

To determine medical, special and fast-track (extension) claims and appeals.

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Noise Specialist; and
- Medical Specialist.

The Panel:

- met via video conference to consider six claims including:
 - o Three medical claims for daily/overnight respite; and
 - Two requests for either the continuation or reinstatement of daily respite awards from residents living close to Tideway's Chambers Wharf site; and
 - One appeal for overnight accommodation to be added to a previous award.
 - These matters were all associated with Tideway works at Chambers Wharf.

2. 28 October 2025 (ICP Meeting #296)
