

Monthly Report of the Independent Compensation Panel Chair

September 2025

The Independent Compensation Panel (the 'Panel') met on three occasions in September 2025.

1. 9 September 2025 (ICP Meeting #292)

Purpose

To determine medical, special and fast-track (extension) claims.

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Noise Specialist; and
- Medical Specialist.

The Panel:

- met via video conference to consider four claims including:
 - Two medical claims for daily respite; and
 - Two requests for either the continuation or reinstatement of daily respite awards from residents living close to Tideway's Chambers Wharf site (one of which was a houseboat resident).
 - These matters were all associated with Tideway works at Chambers Wharf.

The minutes were issued within three working days of the meeting.

2. 10 September 2025 (ICP Meeting #293)

Purpose

To determine loss of rent claims only as the compensation team were unavailable on 9 September.

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Compensation Specialists.

The Panel:

- met via video conference to consider three claims:
 - One claim was a new claim for loss of rent.
 - The two remaining claims were appeals for the Panel to reconsider decisions made on 29 July 2025 and 12 August 2025.
- These matters were associated with Tideway works at:
 - Earl Pumping Station; and
 - Chambers Wharf.

The minutes were issued within four working days of the meeting.

3. 23 September 2025 (ICP Meeting #294)

Purpose

To determine medical, special and fast-track claims (if applicable).

Panel Members

In addition to the Chair, the Panel was comprised of:

- Medical Specialist; and
- Noise Specialist.

The Panel:

- met via video conference to consider twelve claims including:
 - Six medical claims. One of these was from a new houseboat resident making her first claim and another was from a previous claimant making additional demands on medical grounds, some of which had already been awarded;
 - One claim from houseboat residents requesting daily respite which was in addition to a previous award made; and
 - Five claims from residents, living close to Tideway's Chambers Wharf site, wishing to extend their current awards or appeal previous decisions/awards made.
- These matters were associated with Tideway works at Chambers Wharf.

The minutes were issued within four working days of the meeting.
